## A Message from *Our* *Principal*


Dear Trinity Family:

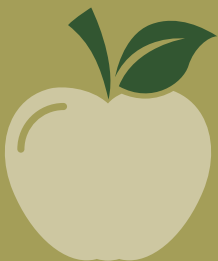

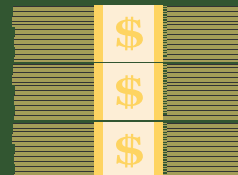

# Faith in Our Future Capital Campaign

Since 1963, Trinity High School has been a pillar of Cumberland County, excelling in academics, athletics, student life, and service. As such, the initiatives outlined in our Capital Campaign effort will help Trinity continue to be the leading educational institution in the community. Our physical facilities are in need of significant upgrades for an enhanced educational environment. The total need for the Campaign is \$8.5 million—with the outside facade and HVAC requiring \$3.1 million, the auditorium renovation costing \$3.2 million, athletic improvements running \$1.2 million, and our STEAM initiative costing \$200,000. To date, generous donors have pledged \$6.6 million, which has brought our campaign close to the finish line. We have completed three-quarters of the facade, the auditorium, athletic improvements, and technology upgrades. We need YOUR help to finish the facade and install air conditioning! ## Outside Facade / HVAC

Trinity installed a new exterior facade on the front of the building and the eastern portion of the rear of the school. The completion of the facade will allow for the installation of a comprehensive, energy-efficient HVAC system. By Design Consultants of Camp Hill has provided the architectural plans for the exterior portion of this project.



## Auditorium

Trinity is in the process of completely renovating our auditorium space, from the stage, to the lighting, to the sound capabilities of the area. New padded seats, flooring, and ceiling will enhance the most important common area in the school, one in which students begin and end their time at Trinity, and where much of our communal liturgical life takes place. This project has a projected completion date of December 2022.

## Athletic Improvements

In the summer of 2022, Trinity installed a turf field and new track at the COBO Field facility to allow for an enhanced competitive experience by our student-athletes. The field will increase the practice space available on our campus and will withstand use by numerous sports teams. This campaign facet also included the installation of new gym bleachers and expansion of the practice area to include a full-sized practice field, which was also completed in the summer of 2022.



## S.T.E.A.M.

Every student and teacher has received a Chromebook equipped with a protective case and insured for many years of productive classroom use. These devices allow students to take a more interactive, creative role in their education and will allow faculty to reach students with different learning styles more effectively.
